MONDAY 4-6pm	Early Readers & Writers Club	The workshop supports early language development through age-appropriate reading and writing activities. MONDAY 4–6pm	VISUAL ARTS	Explore and master a different traditional medium —from pencil and charcoal to acrylic paint and clay. With each session, they progressively delve deeper, learning the intricate facets of visual arts in a detailed, step-by-step approach.
TUESDAY 4–6pm	HOMEWORK HELP/ LINGUISTIC ACADEMY 	Targeted support in French and English to strengthen grammar, vocabulary, reading, writing, and speaking. Includes structured lessons and homework help for bilingual and international learners aiming to improve fluency and school performance.
WEDNESDAY 4–6pm	ACRO YOGA & ARTS	The workshop combines elements of yoga and basic acrobatics to develop strength, balance, and flexibility. Students enhance body awareness, coordination, and focus through guided movement and structured physical practice.
THURSDAY 4–6pm	DIGITAL ART	The workshop develops digital art skills as students work with programs like Procreate and Canva. They use various tools to create animations, digital books, and paintings, exploring visual storytelling in a creative, tech-based environment.
FRIDAY 4–6pm	PLANET HERO	In the Planet Hero workshop, kids explore the Earth through fun, hands-on activities in science, gardening, cooking, recycling, and construction. Each week, they “travel” the planet to learn how it works and how to make it better.
